One of Sauternes original estates, Château de Carmes de Rieussec occupies 227 acres of prime territory in the heart of Bordeaux's sweet wine country. The 2019 vintage was one of the warmest in recent memory in Bordeaux, yet the Sémillon at Rieussec still developed ample botrytis to yield an ultra-aromatic and age-worthy Sauternes. After pressing, the wine was fermented and kept on the lees with regular stirring until December, after which time it was aged in oak barrels for roughly 12 months before bottling.

Our products are from the north east of Italy, Veneto and Friuli Venezia Giulia (except for Montepulciano d'Abruzzo and Bianco di Custoza); the quality of their wines are the results of hard work and technology with direct oversight by our enologists for quality assurance. Around the 70s, Callisto gave to his sons Dario and Bruno the company's care, developing and expanding the business. Collaborating with the producers of the most world renowned in the Veneto, initially the two brothers devoted themselves to supplying local restaurants within a few miles and then expanded gradually to cover most of Europe.

In the 12th century, the French Carthusian monks arrived in the Priory and introduced the varieties that are typical of the region today: Grenache and Carignan. The Marco family, winegrowers since the 15th century, was based in Porrera, as already recorded in the first census of Catalonia (1497) as well as in the subsequent census carried out by the Count of Floridablanca in 1787. At the end of the 19th century, the phylloxera, as in the rest of Europe, devastated the vineyards and the family emigrated to Barcelona while keeping the land of Porrera. In 1898, Ramón Marco Abella was born in Porrera. An enterprising man with a strong character, he decided to revive what had been one of the best vineyards in the Priorat region. OLIVIA and DAVID After a century, his grandson David and his wife Olivia decide to take a step forward by building a modern winery. The couple abandoned their respective professional careers to devote themselves exclusively to their passions and built the Marco Abella winery, thus contributing to the worldwide prestige of Priorat wines. Joe and Pat Harbison's entry into the wine business was anything but typical. Known for his legendary wine cellar, various charities

often called on Joe to create auction lots of rare and exquisite wines. Culling the best wines from his cellar, their generosity helped raise much-needed funds for over three decades. Recognizing wine's importance in fundraising, they decided to produce their own label, JP Harbison, with fruit purchased from Oakville. Norm Roby of Decanter Magazine called their project "the ultimate new boutique brand" when just six cases of the first vintage were made available for sale and the rest donated to charity. JP Harbison produced vintages from 1998 to 2007 and generated over \$3 million for children's charities. The Harbison Estate story was born in 2005 when Joe and Pat were fortunate to find a small parcel of land on Oakville's Eastside and began the development of their wine-growing estate. The site proved ideal for planting Cabernet Sauvignon and sits on the same uplifted alluvial fan and red volcanic dirt as its already famous neighbors. The story of the historic Dusi Vineyard began in the early 1920s, when Sylvester and Caterina Dusi emigrated from Northern Italy and settled in Paso Robles. The Dusi Vineyard introduced some of the first Zinfandels to California's Central Coast; vineyards were rare in Old California in the early 1900's. Sylvester and Caterina were highly enterprising, and working together with their three sons – Guido, Dante and Benito, eventually bought an additional property on the west side of Highway 101 in 1945 and planted Zinfandel. Zinfandel was the Italian varietal of choice at the time, and remains the vineyard's mainstay varietal today. The intense flavor profiles of the "Dusi Fruit" are characteristic of the land's unique micro climate and the family's old-world, handcrafted grape growing techniques, which promotes sustainable vineyards, through use of techniques like cover crop and dry farming. This 100-acre estate is located just south of Paso Robles in the Templeton Gap. A region that features the greatest day-to-night temperature variation of any appellation in California, providing ideal conditions for vibrantly flavored yet exceptionally balanced wines. The vineyard has been sought after by many fine wineries, for the production of old vine zinfandel such as: Turley, McPrice Myers, Ridge, Tobin James, and Grey Wolf. These local wineries have been purchasing the fruit for many years, creating their own versions of Dante Dusi Vineyard designated Zinfandels. Three generations after Janell Dusi's great-grandparents first planted Zinfandel she is continuing the legacy of one of the area's most well loved vineyards, expanding on the family owned business and taking 20 percent of the production off the Family Vineyards to create J Dusi Wines.
