Sustainable

Brunn practices traditional fermentation in small tanks using native yeasts to enhance the beautiful typicity of its vineyards. Below the winery lies an old, historic subterranean cellar where the wines mature in perfect conditions. Both normal barrels and large neutral vats are used in order not to allow the wood to overpower the wine. The winery owns the oldest traditional basket press in this part of Europe, dating back to 1564 A.D. This Renaissance era basket press has never left the village. Originally used by the Benedictine Abby of Gottweig near Krems, it eventually found its way to the makers of Brunn.

One of Sauternes original estates, Château de Carmes de Rieussec occupies 227 acres of prime territory in the heart of Bordeaux's sweet wine country. The 2019 vintage was one of the warmest in recent memory in Bordeaux, yet the Sémillon at Rieussec still developed ample botrytis to yield an ultra-aromatic and age-worthy Sauternes. After pressing, the wine was fermented and kept on the lees with regular stirring until December, after which time it was aged in oak barrels for roughly 12 months before bottling.

Father and son winemakers Guy and Jean-Luc Mardon ran the family estate in the heart of Touraine hand to hand for many years. Today Jean-Luc, the fifth generation, has taken over the day to day work. Jean-Luc Mardon maintains traditional vineyard and winemaking practices. The wine is still aged in the original cellar under the family home in Oisly. Since 1995, the winery has reduced yields and become a member of Terra Vitis, a group that pursues environmentally friendly viticulture, without the use of pesticides. Each parcel is vinified separately before blending. Domaine Guy Mardon is located on a plateau between the Loir and Cher rivers. An Atlantic climate with low rainfall, ample sun and cool nights, combined with sandy soil over a clay base leads to an excellent acidity and aromatics in their grapes.

Parolvini has been a family company since 1916 based in Tezze Sul Brenta, about 70 miles from Venice . Our products are from the north east of Italy, Veneto and Friuli Venezia Giulia (except for Montepulciano d'Abruzzo and Bianco di Custoza); the quality of their wines are the results of hard work and technology with direct oversight by our enologists for quality assurance. Around the 70s, Callisto gave to his sons Dario and Bruno the company's care, developing and expanding the business. Collaborating with the producers of the most world renowned in the Veneto, initially the two brothers devoted themselves to supplying local restaurants within a few miles and then expanded gradually to cover most of Europe.

He never saw himself creating a new and original vermouth formula until he crossed paths with Alex and they started discussing how artisanal Piedmont craftsmanship could inspire the taste of a new generation. 9diDANTE comes to life as a modern liquid version of the poem, La Divina Comedia written by Dante Alighieri in 1320 narrating Dante's travels through Hell and Purgatory on his way to Paradise. To us, Vermouth is a power struggle between Wormwood and all the other botanicals, told in a language that everyone can understand, wine.

In the 12th century, the French Carthusian monks arrived in the Priory and introduced the varieties that are typical of the region today: Grenache and Carignan. The Marco family, winegrowers since the 15th century, was based in Porrera, as already recorded in the first census of Catalonia (1497) as well as in the subsequent census carried out by the Count of Floridablanca in 1787. At the end of the 19th century, the phylloxera, as in the rest of Europe, devastated the vineyards and the family emigrated to Barcelona while keeping the land of Porrera. In 1898, Ramón Marco Abella was born in Porrera. An enterprising man with a strong character, he decided to revive what had been one of the best vineyards in the Priorat region. OLIVIA and DAVID After a century, his grandson David and his wife Olivia decide to take a step forward by building a modern winery. The couple abandoned their respective professional careers to devote themselves exclusively to their passions and built the Marco Abella winery, thus contributing to the worldwide prestige of Priorat wines. It was said that growing grapes of any kind in this region would be a ludicrous effort, however, Crane's determination would soon tell otherwise. Nested in the alluvial fan of the Mayacamas Mountain range in southern St. Helena, it is believed that here is where G.B. Crane first established grapes on the site back in 1858 where he was set to produce wines that would rival the best in the world. He began his mission by introducing Napa to Vinifera (European) Varietals. Although records are scarce, it was most likely planted as a field blend commonly known as "mixed blacks". This field blend traditionally consisted of Zinfandel, Petite Sirah, Carignan, and a smattering of lesser-known grape varieties such as Alicante Bouschet, Mourvedre and Valdiguié. He chose to reject straight lines. "The straight line is godless. The straight line is the only uncreative line", said Hundertwasser as he criticized straight lines of modern architecture as evil tools of uniformity that restricts originality, sense of self and connection with the nature. As you study Quixote's building, get ready to be dazzled by the colorful mosaics and free flow of curves.

He's the person who works in the vineyard, sorts the fruit, ferments the grapes, bottles the wine, cleans the equipment and floor, writes the letters, signs the checks, among other things. The journey that took George to Sonoma County, California began on a small island in Southern New York State commonly referred to as The Big Apple. After growing up in NYC, George went on to Lehigh University in Bethlehem, Pennsylvania, the University of Chicago Graduate School of Business, and the University of Houston Law Center. Following nine years in academia, and significant financial debt, George moved to Los Angeles and became a United States Government Bond trader. During a fourteen year career as a bond trader, George arrived at work five days a week at five in the morning. In 1994, about ten years into his trading career, George had some Williams Selyem Rochioli Vineyard Pinot Noir with his seared ahi dinner. That night, George had an epiphany, as wine became an equal partner with food in the dining experience, and decided that one day he would move to Sonoma County to make Russian River Valley Pinot Noir.
